- *** unit meals represent workload handled by Catering staff - whereby each meal type (e.g. dinner, lunch, etc) is given a different unit meal weightage factor.

Commentary:

Flights, passengers and cargo/mail grew in November 2005 compared to the same period last year. However, there was a drop in the number of meals produced primarily due to lower passenger numbers on mainstream airlines. The growth in passenger numbers is largely attributed to the low cost carriers.
