Commentary:

All operating indices, except for cargo/mail processed, showed growth in September 2005 compared with the corresponding month a year ago. The rapid growth of low cost carriers (LCCs) has contributed significantly to the growth in flight and passenger volumes.

Operating indices for 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter FY2005-06 improved year on year. They also showed increases compared to the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of FY2005-06 (i.e. improvement of 1.2% for flights handled, 4.4% for cargo/mail processed, 5.2% for passengers handled and 6.9% for gross meals produced).
